SGM (R) Russell's obituary

SGM (Retired) Russell "Haloman" W. McDaniel March 10, 1958 – June 26, 2023

We lost a great Warrior. God called to Arms to the Army of the Lord, Sergeant Major (Retired) Russ "Haloman" McDaniel. He passed away on June 26, 2023 in Valrico, FL.

He was born March 10th, 1958 in Camden, NJ and graduated from Woodrow Wilson HS (Class of 1976). At the age of 18, Russ enlisted in the U.S. Army.

Russ served in the Army for 30 years retiring as a Sergeant Major. He began his career as an Observation/Scout Helicopter Repairer., followed by service in the 82nd ABN DIV as a paratrooper. As an Elite Special Forces Non-Commissioned Officer, he served around the world assigned to 7th, 3rd, and 1st Special Forces Group. He was the Class President of the Sergeants Major Academy in 1999. His last reenlistment ceremony occurred in free fall accompanied by multi-service General Officers at MacDill AFB, Tampa, FL.

He achieved multiple awards throughout his military career, including the Legion of Merit and two Bronze Star Medals.

Upon retiring from military service from Special Operations Command Headquarters, MacDill AFB, he became a Department of Defense Federal Employee at Special Operations Command until he retired from civil service in 2022. He was a former Non-Commissioned Officer in charge of the SOCOM Para-Commandos Parachute Team. He was a USPA coach and videographer.

In 2014, he parachuted with the Liberty Jump Team, commemorating the 70th Anniversary of D-Day in Normandy,

France. He completed over 3000+ parachute jumps in his lifetime.

He was a member of various Military and Veteran Service organizations to include a Life Member of the Special Forces Association and a Life Member of the Veterans of Foreign War.

Russ is remembered for his quick wit and humorous banter. He was "Haloman" if he couldn't do it, nobody can. He was 160lbs of twisted steel and sex appeal, a steely-eyed, barrel-chested freedom fighter: but would shed tears when watching "It's a Wonderful Life". Beloved by all and will be remembered in the hearts of many who knew him.

He is preceded in death by his Mother, Helen Sulzbach, Step-Father, Walter Sulzbach and son Fitzpatrick. He is survived by his Forever Love, wife of 33 years, Roserita M. McDaniel; Daughter Stephanie McDaniel: Sister Helen Sulzbach; Fatherin-Law Jackie E. Boggess; Sister-in-Law Colonel (Retired) Corrina M. Boggess; and other extended Family members.

A Memorial "ash drop" is scheduled October 14th, 2023 (2pm) at Skydive City in Zephryhills, FL where his fellow military skydivers will release a portion of his ashes for his final jump. He will be inurned at Arlington National Cemetery at a future date.
